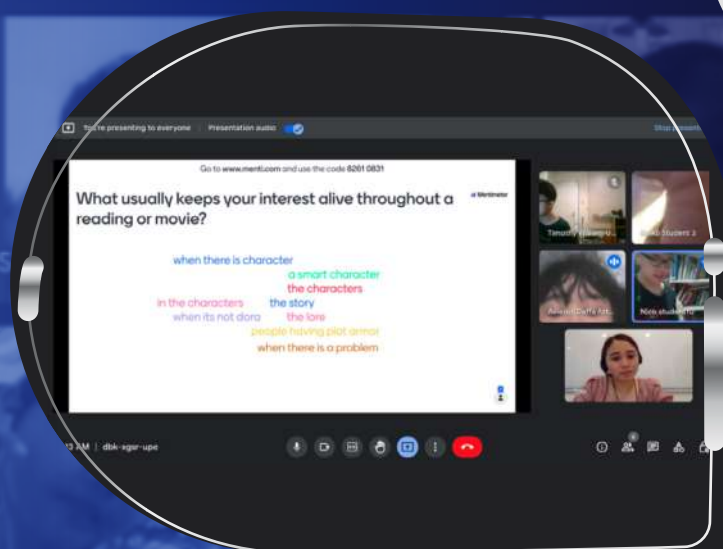

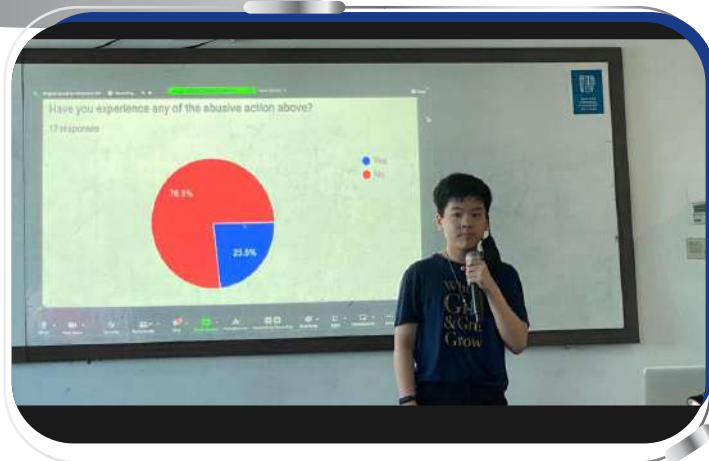




# Passion Project

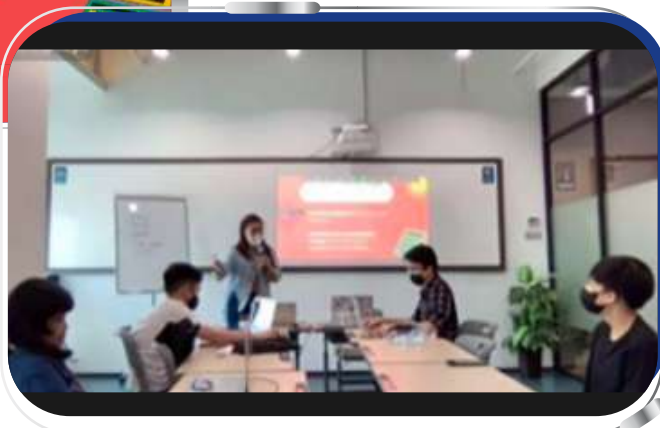

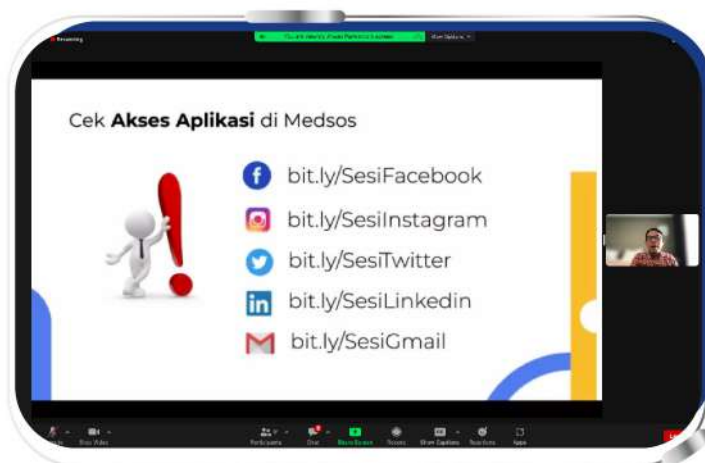


# Parent Teacher Meeting

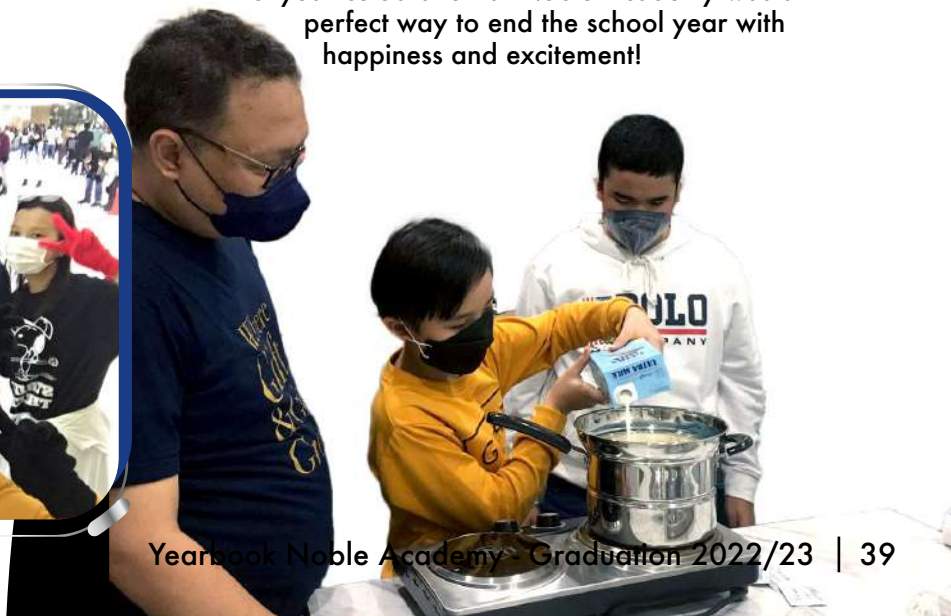

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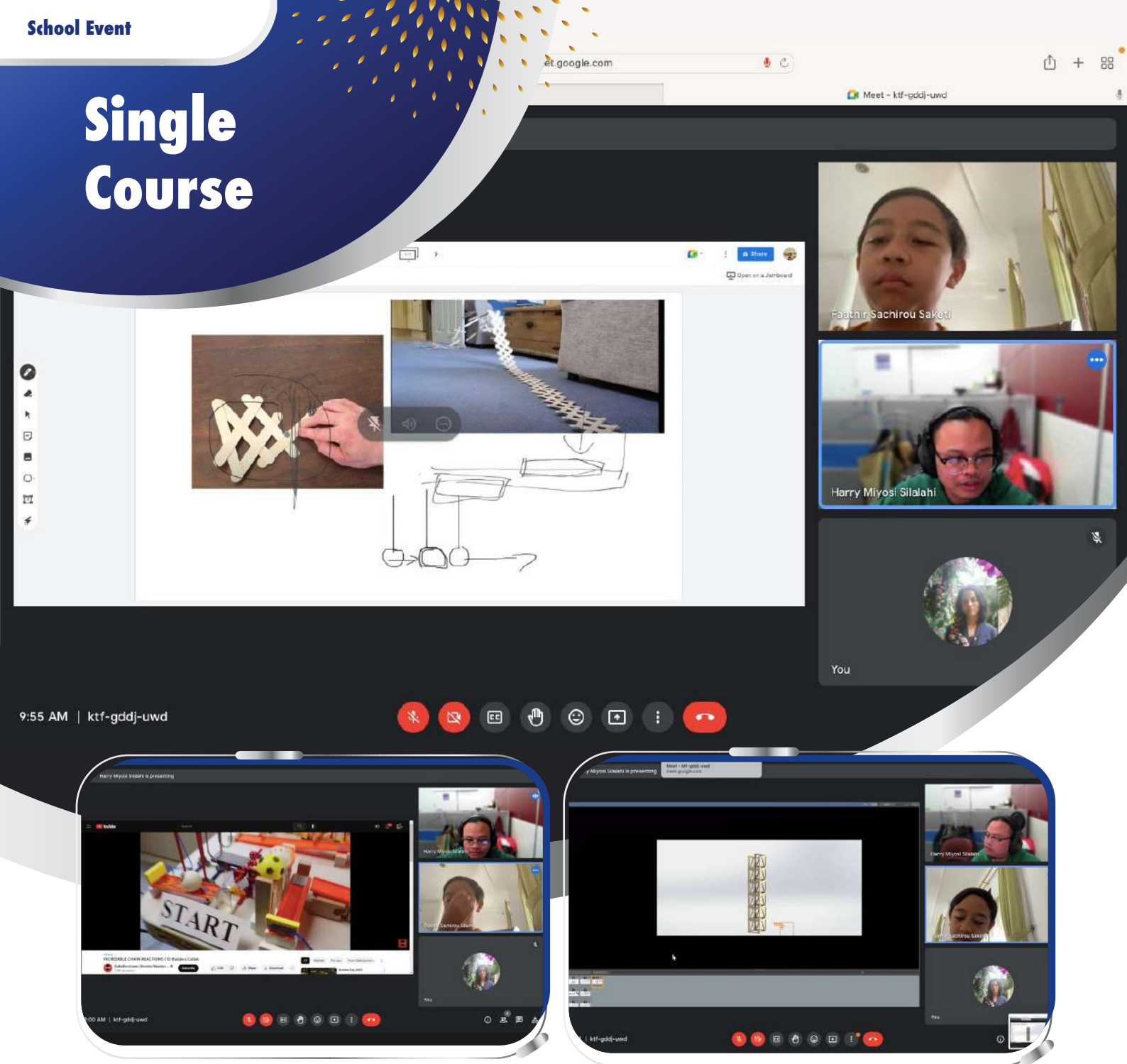


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# Single Course

# STEM

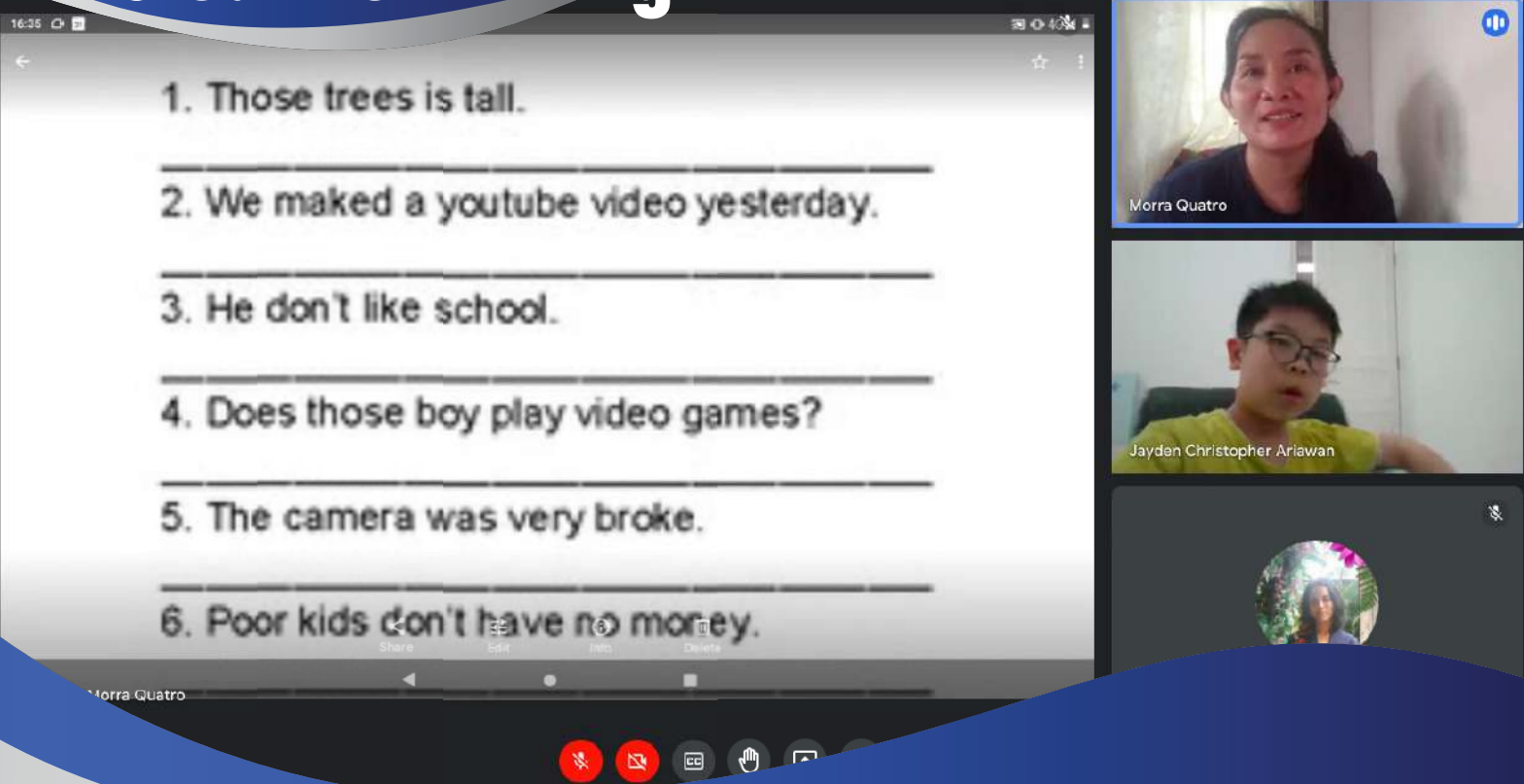

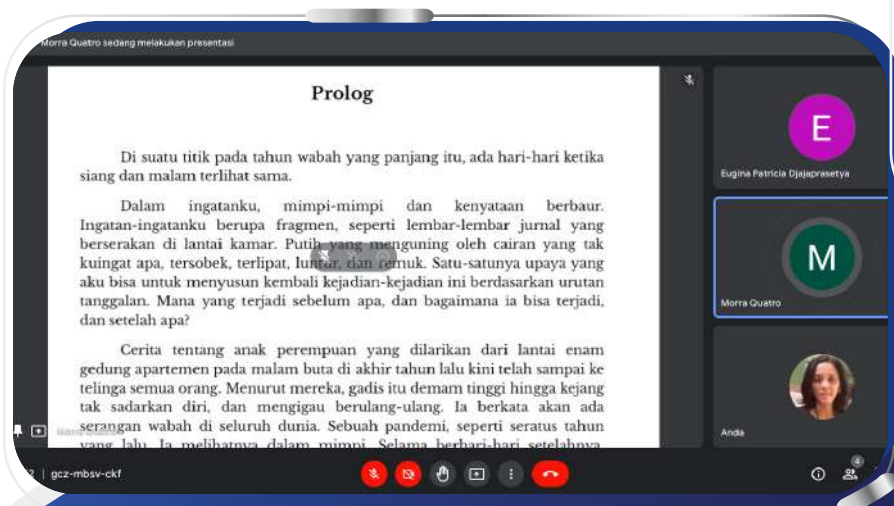


# Creative Writing
